

PROJECT NAME: Hazardous Air Pollutants Emissions Notice

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Colorado Legislature passed Senate Bill 105, also known as the Colorado Clean Air Act, in August 1992. This law requires all owners or operators of any activity or process that can emit air pollution to report to the Colorado Air Pollution Control Division. The pollutants that must be reported are the criteria pollutants and hazardous air pollutants (HAPs). The HAPs include more than 600 listed compounds designated by the Colorado Clean Air Act. The requirements cover air pollution emissions greater than 100 pounds per year per source.

EIS is evaluated sources of air emissions from manufacturing processes. EIS completed a review of MSDS data and 12-month consumption of raw materials, solvents, and paints in order to determine yearly emissions of HAPs
